**Job Goal:** To plan, organize and implement an appropriate instructional program in an elementary or secondary learning environment that guides and encourages students to develop and fulfill their God given academic potential.

## **Performance Responsibilities:**

- 1. Complies with policies and procedures established for St. John the Evangelist Catholic School in the Diocese of Savannah in accordance with the philosophy of Catholic Education.
- 2. Has an overall knowledge of the school's mission and can relate specific expertise to these goals.
- 3. Reflects in personal and professional life a commitment to Gospel values and their Christian tradition.
- 4. Accepts and supports the community of faith not simply as a concept to be taught, but as a reality to be lived in worship, service, and interpersonal relationships.
- 5. Is punctual in attendance and in the performance of duties.
- 6. Dresses in a professional manner.
- 7. Delivers lesson plans and instructional materials that facilitate active learning.
- 8. Instructs and monitors students in the use of learning materials and equipment.
- 9. Uses relevant technology to support and differentiate instruction.
- 10. Manages student behavior in the classroom by establishing and enforcing rules and procedures.
- 11. Maintains discipline in accordance with the rules and disciplinary systems of the school.
- 12. Prepares classroom for class activities.
- 13. Provides a variety of learning materials and resources for use in educational activities.
- 14. Demonstrates preparation and skill in working with students from diverse cultural, economic and ability backgrounds.
- 15. Remains at school the entire school day, unless otherwise instructed to leave by building principal.
- 16. Performs other duties as assigned.
